TransInfo connects you to travel information for buses, trains and ferries in South East Queensland.

For the cost of a local call, TransInfo makes your travel as easy and as simple as possible by providing:

- timetable, route and fare details for buses, Citytrain, Airtrain and ferries
- locations of bus stops, train stations and ferry terminals and walking distances to services
- details about interconnecting services
- public transport information linked to special events
- information about accessible services

TransInfo operates services for non-English speaking callers, and for hearing impaired and speech impaired users.

TransInfo operates from 6am to 9pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 9pm on weekends and public holidays\*.

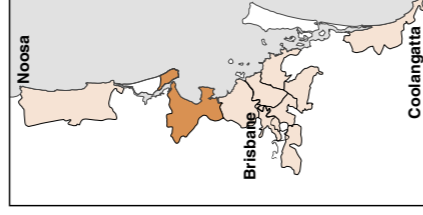

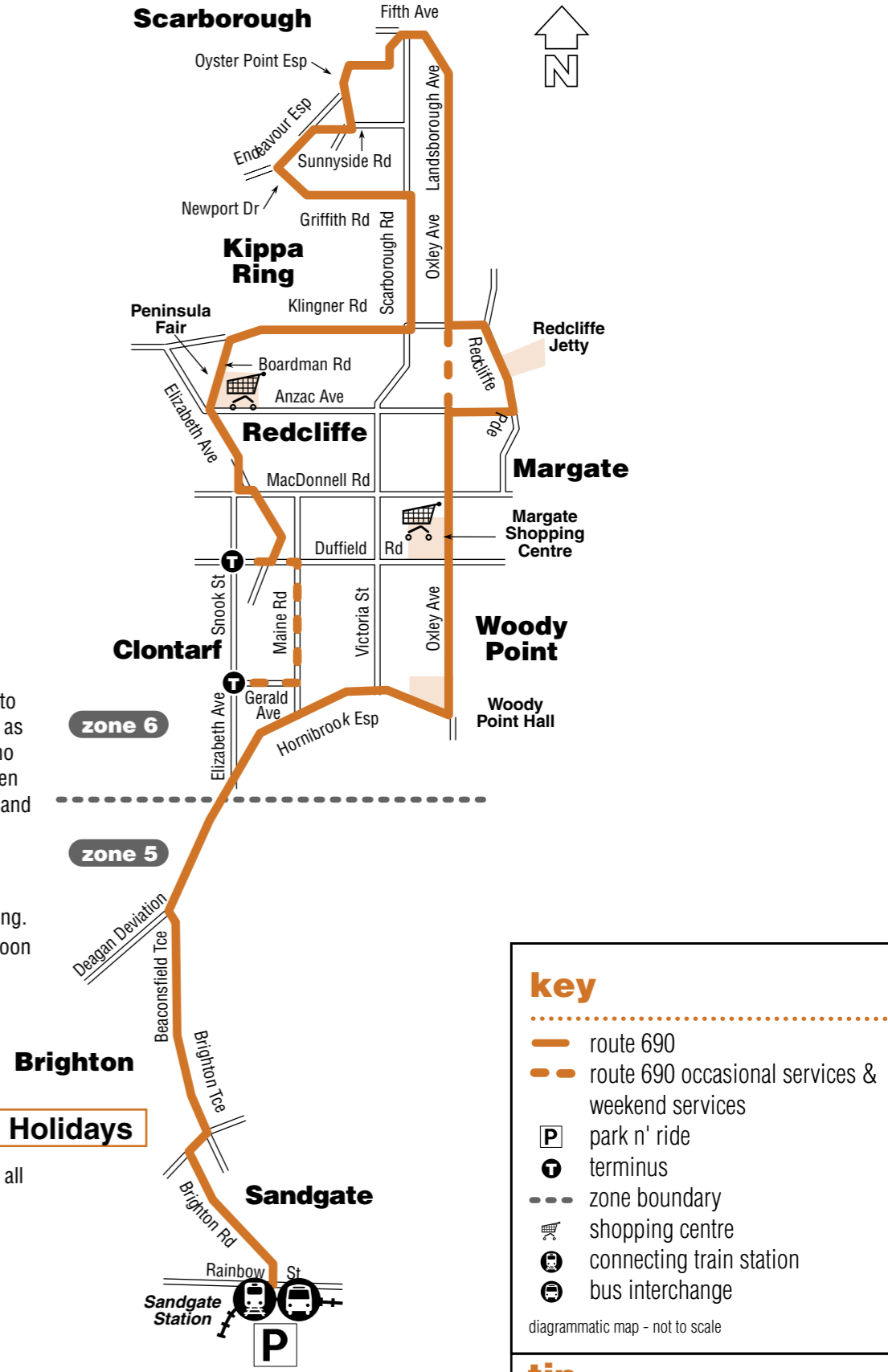
